## Tribal Sovereignty and Economic Development Opportunities

### • State Laws

- Can either over-regulate or prohibit certain economic development activities and opportunities;
- State Laws generally do not apply to Indian Tribes.
- Federal Laws
  - May not over-regulate or prohibit certain economic development activities or opportunities;
  - Federal Laws generally apply to Tribes (In the case of Lending, Tribes are treated as "States").
- Tribal Laws
  - True Exercise of Sovereignty; Tribal laws may allow an activity otherwise prohibited by State law;
  - Tribal Laws Apply.
