






Why does the human right to water fail?

- Water is different than other natural resources
 - Adam Smith's Water/Diamond Paradox
- Water provision as natural monopoly
 - Cost Recovery
 - Cost Internalization
 - Institutional Competency & Enforcement
 - Concession Contracting, Transparency, & Corruption
