Dorothy J. Glancy, is Professor of Law at Santa Clara University School of Law and a graduate of Wellesley College (B.A.) and Harvard Law School (J.D.). She is a member of the bar in the District of Columbia and in California and a certified Information Privacy Professional (CIPP/US).

Professor Glancy studies legal issues related to law and technology, including how privacy interacts with transportation. She serves as a member of the National Academy of Science Committee on the Long-Term Stewardship of Driver Safety Data (SHRP 2) and is an advisor to the federal interagency scientific working group with regard to speaker recognition.

Professor Glancy serves as co-chair of the e-business subcommittee of the Court Technology Advisory Committee to the State of California Judicial Council. Her publications include such topics as autonomous vehicles, automobile "black boxes," and Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS).
