

Prof. Kuzma is Associate Professor in Science, Technology and Environmental Policy at the Humphrey School of Public Affairs and director of the Initiative on the Governance of Emerging Technological Systems (iGETs) at the University of Minnesota.

Prof. Kuzman has published over 60 scholarly articles, book chapters, and reports on the policy, legal, risk governance, and ethical aspects of emerging technologies and has served on several international and national panels in these areas including for the UN-FAO, U.S. FDA, and EU. She was elected Chair of the Gordon Research Conference on Science and Technology Policy for 2014.

Prior to coming to the University of Minnesota, Prof. Kuzma was a study and program director at the U.S. National Academies for biotechnology and bioterrorism and a AAAS Risk Policy Fellow at the USDA.
