
























Facebook experimental facial recognition technology matches faces in two photographs with 97.25% accuracy.

Any behavior observed by anyone may potentially be watched by anyone else at anytime on the web.

## **Political / Legal Solution**

- Privacy law traditionally aimed primarily at privacy infringements from state and corporate agents
- Privacy law must be revamped to protect against similar invasions from "the herd"

## **Political / Legal Obstacles**

- 1. Invasion in public spaces
  - No reasonable expectation of privacy

- 2. Free speech issues
  - Shutting down sites is a violation
